TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN THROUGHOUT THE GLOBE.— *Health, Happiness and Stability.*—Know ye all, that at an adjourned communication of the National Grand Lodge of the United States, held at the Masonic Hall, South Eleventh street, Philadelphia, the following resolutions were unanimously adopted:

Resolved. That the person who clandestinely assumes the office of Grand Master of the Grand Lodge for the State of Pennsylvania, be expelled (he having violated the 9th and 11th articles of the Constitution, as agreed to in solemn convention assembled, June, 1847—A. L. 5847,) for ninety-nine years, nine months, nine weeks, nine days, nine hours, nine minutes, and nine seconds, and that the warrant he now holds be annulled.

Article 1 of the Constitution of the National Grand Lodge.—All State Grand Lodges shall invariably acknowledge the N. G. L.

Art. 9. No State Grand Lodge of Color, shall be taken to fellowship, nor be considered legal, which does not hold its warrant under this N. G. L., and agreeably to the declaration of sentiments as signed in convention, by the delegates of the several Grand Lodges in convention assembled.

Art. 11. All State Grand Lodges who shall refuse to comply with all the doings of the N. G. L., shall not be considered in fellowship, and as such shall be recorded.

And be it further Resolved, That the two persons clandestinely assuming the offices of Senior and Junior Grand Wardens of the G. L. for the State of Pennsylvania, are hereby expelled for aiding and abetting in the above plot of conspiracy, in endeavoring to destroy the N. G. L., by false representations, for and during the full end and term of ninety-nine years, nine months, nine weeks, nine days, nine hours, nine minutes, and nine seconds, they having also violated, in connection with the said Grand Master, the 8th section of the laws of Ahimion Rezon, pledged in convention never to be broken—Page 47.

Resolved, That the above expulsions take effect forthwith, and be published in one of the daily papers. (Extract from the minutes.)
